#### **OVERVIEW**

MY Policy Bootcamp is a 16-week capacity-building programme developed to instil an appreciation of the importance of public policy and an understanding of the policymaking process among Malaysian youth. The programme is crafted with a multi-modal approach, comprising a series of masterclasses and workshops, self-learning, and mentoring sessions to ensure a strong foundation in policymaking among the participants, not only theoretically but also practically.

With a better understanding of the policymaking process, we hope our youths will be able to contribute to more effective policy debates and meaningful policy suggestions in Malaysia. At the end of this programme, participants stand a chance to bring home seed funding to advocate for their proposed policy solutions.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- To create a platform for youth to engage in public policymaking systemically and based on actual process;
- To develop social and civic competencies among youths in Malaysia; and
- To inculcate a culture of objective policy discussions and critique among Malaysian youth.
